Venture to rugged, remote country in the Colorado mountains for a 7-day public land elk hunt for up to four hunters. You will be accompanied and hosted by the Hecht family as you embark upon their treasured hunting spot.

Hunters are provided with a wall tent, cots, woodstove and fire wood. The camp cook will serve home cooked meals after a long day of hunting. There will also be assistance with field preparation and packing out of elk. Your game can be delivered to a reputable taxidermist if desired.

Hunt must take place during archery, muzzleloader, first or second rifle season. Hunters must purchase over the counter bull tags or Gary Hecht may assist you in putting in for a draw tag. Hunters must provide their own gun or bow, ammunition and hunting necessities.

Must be used in 2023 elk hunting season. Hunting season to be coordinated with Gary Hecht. Hunting to take place in Colorado, hunting unit arranged with Gary Hecht. Airfare not included.
